This is an opportunity for our grantees to build and highlight partnerships and the great work they do.
- Partners from local organizations have helped to make these events possible and have demonstrated how communities evolve when people committed to change come together to make it happen.

Lead Safe and Healthy Neighborhood BUILD Events Project Overview (continued)

- The OLHCHH will assist the local grantee as well as bring support of national partners for a local event where volunteers can help "finish" units and unveil the lead safe and healthy neighborhood.
- Volunteers will come together to provide critical home repairs, accessibility modifications and other improvements to 3-5 homes in the identified neighborhood.

Lead Safe and Healthy Neighborhood BUILD Events Project Overview (continued)

- Many event have included a Listening Session to provide high level officials, community based organizations, and members of the local communities, a forum to discuss areas of lead hazard control, housing and neighborhood safety and health, the importance of expanding partnerships, developing workforce opportunities, and identify areas of opportunity and improvement.
- OLHCHH will be working with the National League of Cities to encourage participation from the Mayors Office as well as work to get the Mayor's support and participation in a Mayor's Challenge for creating Lead Safe and Healthy Neighborhoods.




